Why Visit China in Winter

Winter, from November to March, is also the low tourist season in China. Usually, there are fewer travelers in low season, so you will have more space and time to enjoy your trip to the full. In fact, most of the popular destinations, such as Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an and Chengdu, are still very accessible in winter time. And the accommodation cost and transportation fares will be cheaper than that in peak season. Some tourist sites also offer cheaper tickets for low season.



Itinerary in brief

- Day 1, 29 Dec | Arrive Shanghai.
- Day 2, 30 Dec | Shanghai. 1 Full day of excursion.
- Day 3, 31 Dec | Shanghai. 1 Full day excursion.
- Day 4, 01 Jan | Depart for Lhasa. 2 hours old town walk.
- Day 5, 02 Jan | Lhasa. 1 Full day excursion.
- Day 6, 03 Jan | Depart for Xi'an. Evening Xi'an city tour.
- Day 7, 04 Jan | Xi'an. Brief Xi'an city tour + Terracotta excursion, depart for Chengdu (by train).
- Day 8, 05 Jan | Chengdu. 1 Full day excursion, Panda with holding option + old town city tour.
- Day 9, 06 Jan | Depart Chengdu for Zhangjiajie. 6:00 hours excursion.
- Day 10, 07 Jan | Drive to Fenghuang. 5:00 hours excursion.
- Day 11, 08 Jan | Drive to Guilin via Longsheng. 4:00 hours excursion in Longsheng.
- Day 12, 09 Jan | Li river Cruise from Guilin to Yangsho + Impression Sanjie Liu Show.
- Day 13, 10 Jan | Transfer to Guilin and depart for Beijing. 7:00 hours Mutianyu or Simatai GW .
- Day 14, 11 Jan | Beijing. 1 full day excursion.
- Day 15, 12 Jan | Transfer to Beijing airport and departure.
